DRIVING RULES AND TIPS

Driving Side: Right

Maximum Speed Limits : 80mph

Drunk Driving Penalties :

Vary from state to state

but all of them are very heavy

ROAD CONDITIONS

Be good carefully and drive slowly
when traveling in **Washington, California,**
and **Illinois** since there are close to or
beyond 70% roads are poor or mediocre.

TOLL ROADS & E-TAGS

i. Electronic Transponder

Usually costs more than the electronic
transponder.



BUYING PETROL/GAS

i. Self-service payment at the pump:

Cash is recommended.

(your credit card may be rejected
if you are not an American)

ii. Pay at the fuel station: cash or credit card



PARKING

i. Cash:

Some smaller towns use coin meters for
parking payment, so prepare coins in advance

ii. Credit Card:

Parking meters or payment kiosks
